

Grad Bio – Graduation Ceremonies

This will be read as you walk to collect your diploma at Graduation ceremonies on Saturday, June 18, 2016. The following are some examples. **NOTE: the length, tone, and content.**

SAMPLE 1: Samantha Leduc-Viscusi usually has her nose in a book. She plans to travel the globe, just not in her '86 Park Avenue Buick.

SAMPLE 2: Graeme McClintock is known for playing guitar. Next year, he will attend John Abbott in social science and pursue a career in business.

SAMPLE 3: Cory Ovans is known for his charming and charismatic personality and for being exceptionally punctual with all of his schoolwork (said sarcastically).

SAMPLE 4: Andrea Soesbergen lives in her cowboy boots and writes songs the whole school sings. She'll study Health Sciences at Marianopolis.

SAMPLE 5: Vanessa Templeton is known for randomly singing in the halls and having constant hiccups. She'll be at Abbott in Language and Literature.
