What is SNAC?

The **Special Needs Advisory Committee** is mandated by Quebec's Education Act.

We advise the Board on topics and funding related to students with special needs.

Who is on the committee?

- Parents of students who have special needs or an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) are eligible for election and form the majority of the Committee;
- The DG's representative - our Coordinator of Complementary Services;
- Representatives from school administration, professionals, teachers and support staff.

There is at least one parent:

- of an elementary student
- of a secondary student
- from the Chateaugay area
- from the Chateaugay Valley area

Strategies to help you support your child with special needs.

Info sessions on various topics including IEPs, transitioning to high school or adult education, anxiety, assistive technologies, and more!
